This Privacy Policy pertains to the mobile application (App) of One Heart Health, owned and operated by One Heart Health, a non-profit organization dedicated to improving pediatric heart health worldwide. This Privacy Policy outlines how we collect, use, and protect your personal information. By signing up and using the App, you agree to the terms of this Privacy Policy.

1. Data We Collect

We may collect the following data in order to assist you and your clients in health care, as well as improve our services:

Personal Information:

- Name
- Date of Birth
- Email Address
- Country

Health Data:

- Phonocardiogram
- Heart sound recordings
- Oxygen saturations
- Weight
- Height
- Consultation notes on heart disease assessment
- General notes pertaining to health

2. How We Collect Your Data

We collect data directly from you when:

- You register and create an account in the App.
- You input health data manually or through connected devices.
- Your assigned pediatric cardiologist or nurse updates your records.

3. How We Use Your Data

Your data is used strictly for the purposes outlined below:

- To provide personalized healthcare services.
- To allow pediatric cardiologists and nurses assigned to your care to access and manage your health data.
- To improve healthcare services by training and utilizing AI systems developed by One Heart Health.
- To ensure compliance with legal and regulatory requirements.

4. Data Sharing

We value your privacy and only share your data in the following circumstances:

- **Healthcare Providers:** Your assigned pediatric cardiologists and nurses may access your data to provide appropriate care.
- **Internal Use:** Data may be used internally to train AI systems developed and maintained by One Heart Health to improve pediatric heart health.
- **Legal Compliance:** We may disclose your information to comply with applicable laws, regulations, or legal processes.

We do not sell, rent, or share your data with third-party advertisers or analytics platforms.

5. Data Retention and Deletion

Retention Policy:

We retain your data as long as necessary to provide healthcare services and comply with legal obligations.

Deletion Policy:

You have the right to request deletion of your personal and health data at any time. To do so, please contact us at “contact@onehearthealth.org”. Upon verification of your identity, we will delete your data within 30 days, except when retention is required for legal or regulatory reasons.

6. User Consent and Data Control

You have control over your data and can:

- Revoke consent for data collection and processing.
 - Access, update, or correct your data by logging into your account.
 - Request a copy of your data by contacting us at “contact@onehearthealth.org”.
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7. Data Security

We use industry-standard measures to protect your data, provided by Amazon Web Services, including:

- Encryption during data transmission and storage.
- Secure servers with restricted access.
- Regular security audits and compliance checks.

8. Children’s Privacy

Our App is intended for use by healthcare professionals managing pediatric patients. If you are a minor, your data will only be accessed or managed by authorized healthcare providers with the consent of your parent or legal guardian.
